

Pioneer Showdown - Lamb Show Rules

1. Entry fee is \$25 per head per show or \$45 for both shows.
2. Pre-registration will be available as well as day of show entries will be available. Please watch Pioneer Showdown Facebook Page for updates.
3. Open to any individuals 21 and under
4. Animals should not arrive before 6:00 a.m. on May 4th, 2025, unless prior arrangements have been made.
5. All lambs must have Scrapie Ear Tags and will be checked at registration. The show hosts reserve the right to decline lambs that do not obtain this tag.
6. Weigh-in from 6:30 a.m. - 9 a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS
7. Lamb classes will be split by breed & weight, with breeds being Hampshire, Suffolk, Natural Colored, Crossbred, Speckled, Southdown, and Dorset.
8. We will have a class for Suffolk's, but they won't be awarded for WCLA points.
9. Commercial Ewes will be shown in their own stand-alone show within the two lamb shows. Ewes CAN NOT be shown in both the market lamb show and commercial ewe show.
10. Commercial Ewe show will be broken down into White Face Commercial and Black Face Commercial.
11. Per WCLA guidelines one showmanship class will be held instead of two.
12. There is no limit to the number of animals entered by one person.
13. Awards given for class winners & breed champions prorated based on entries.
14. All out of state lambs must have health papers and be individually identified on health certificates and state animals are "Free of Diseases."
15. Any evidence of sore mouth, ringworm, foot rot, pink eye, wool fungus, or other contagious diseases in one lamb will disqualify the entire trailer and they will be asked to leave.
16. Show officials reserve the right to make the final interpretation of the show rules.
17. All rules are outlined by the Wisconsin Club Lamb Association will be taken into action and can be found at **wisconsinclublambassociation.com**
18. No painting allowed Ring Side.
19. No stands allowed within the show ring barn.
20. WCLA BREED CLASSIFICATION GUIDELINES APPLIED.
21. WCLA SANCTIONED.
22. NO PENS WILL BE PROVIDED.
23. Showmanship classes:
 1. Beginner: ages 9 and under
 2. Junior: ages 10 to 12
 3. Intermediate: ages 13 to 15
 4. Senior: ages 16 to 18
 5. Collegiate: 19 to 21

24. Absolutely no harsh handling of animals allowed. This includes hitting or smacking.
