1. Entry fee is \$20.00 per head.
2. Open to any individuals 21 and under.
3. Animals should not arrive before 7:30 a.m. on May 21, 2017, unless prior arrangements have been made.
4. Weigh-in from 7:00 a.m.-8:30 a.m. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
5. Meat goats will be shown first. Lamb classes to be split by breed & weight, with breeds being Hampshire, Suffolk, Natural Colored, Crossbred, White Face AOB, and Commercial Ewe.
6. The 1st show will start tentatively at 10:00 am. Showmanship will be immediately following the 1st show. 2nd show will begin approximately at noon.
7. There is no limit to the number of animals entered by one person.
8. Awards given for class winners & breed champions pro rated based on entries.
9. All out of state lambs must have health papers and be individually identified on the health certificates and state animals are "Free of Diseases."
10. Any evidence of sore mouth, ringworm, foot rot, pink eye, wool fungus or other contagious diseases in one lamb will disqualify the entire trailer and they will be asked to leave.
11. Show officials reserve the right to make the final interpretation of the show rules.
12. All rules outlined by the Wisconsin Club Lamb Association will be taken into action and can be found at **wisconsinclublambassociation.com**
13. No painting allowed Ring Side.
14. WCLA BREED CLASSIFICATION GUIDELINES APPLY.
15. WCLA SANCTIONED.
16. NO PENS WILL BE PROVIDED. Penning in other barns will not be allowed.

1. Entry fee is \$20.00 each.
2. Open to any individual 21 and under.
3. Animals should not arrive before 8:00 a.m. on May 21, 2017, unless prior arrangements have been made.
4. Weigh-in from 8:30 a.m.-10:00 a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. Each breed will have their own class regardless of entry numbers. However, low entry classes may not receive awards.
6. The show will start tentatively at 11:00 a.m.
7. All pigs must be born after December 1, 2016
8. There is no limit to the number of animals entered by one person.
9. Awards given for class winners & breed champions pro-rated based on entries & at the discretion of the show officials.
10. All HOGS must have health papers and be individually identified on the health certificates and state animals are "Free of Diseases."
11. We will select a grand & reserve barrow and grand & reserve gilt with no supreme overall.
12. All purebreds must meet respective breed characteristics.
13. Showmanship class divisions will be posted for youth to sign up. The show will begin with showmanship.
14. Show officials reserve the right to make the final interpretation of the show rules.
15. We respect and honor the International Show Ring Code of Ethics.
16. WSPA sanctioned show.
17. We will follow WSPA rules.

Meat Goat Rules

1. Entry fee is \$10.00 each.
2. Open to any individual 21 and under.
3. NO DAIRY GOAT OPTION THIS YEAR. ONLY MEAT GOATS.
4. Animals should not arrive before 7:30 a.m. on May 21, 2017, unless prior arrangements have been made.
5. Check-in from 7:00-8:30 a.m. NO EXCEPTIONS
6. All out of state animals must have health papers and be identified as "Disease Free"
7. Scrapie tags are required on all animals OR registration papers must be shown with tattoos.
8. There is no limit to the number of animals entered by one person.
9. This list is subject to change based on numbers present.
10. Showmanship- Goat showmanship will follow the meat goat show.
 1. Novice- Never shown Before
 2. Junior- Age 8-11
 3. Intermediate- Age 12-15
 4. Senior- Age 16-21

Meat Does-This section includes Boers, Kikos, Spanish and meat cross breeds ONLY

1. Junior Kid-Born after April 1, 2016
2. Senior Kid- Born between January 1, 2017 and April 1, 2017
3. Yearling Doe- Born between January 1, 2016 and January 1, 2017
4. 1-3 Year old doe
5. 3-5 Year old doe
6. 5 and older doe
